





## OUR PORT HAS BLUE FLAG PLEASE, RESPECT THIS CODE OF ENVIRONMENTAL PRACTICES

- 1. Keep informed about the location and features of **environmental sensitive areas of ecological, socieconomical and scientific relevance**, as well as **wildlife reserves and protected ecosystems**, in order to not cause them accidental damages
- 2. Preserve sealife. Respect the marine organisms paying special attention to protected species, and do not disturb birds in nest. Do not use prohibited fishing and farming gears and comply with the closed fishing seasons and do not catch or eat specimens that do not fulfill the minimum landing sizes established in regulations
- 3. Do not anchor in sensitive areas or places where you may interfere with fishing activities. Fulfill diving and underwater fishing regulations
- 4. Promote a responsible environmental management of the port of call (both regular and occasional) according to the Blue Flag criteria. Accomplish with the coastal and environmental regulations, save water and energy and collect garbage selectively. Get involved and encourage the development of environmental management systems as well as environmental educational activities addressed to the technical staff and port end-users
- 5. Adopt a responsible environmental behaviour in the daily life, at home, at work and in the social life as well as in the sea, and take part actively in social or institutional initiatives which look for promoting research, conservation and/or sustainable coastal development
- 6. Make a right use of the boatyard and its facilities. Use environmentally friendly products (coatings, antifouling, paints removal products, cleaners etc.). Put their scraps (and other products such as used oils) in suitable containers located in the port and intended to the selective collection of these products. Use the port facilities addressed to the collection of bilge waters and watertight WC
- 7. Keep the sea, the beach and the port clean by not throwing plastic wastes, butts or other marine litter, by not spilling oil or other harmful substances. Promote recycling and collect solid waste in a selective way. Use properly containers and bins
- 8. Report to the competent authorities any witnessed violation of the marine legislation, especially oil spills (hydrocarbons or other chemical substances) of terrestrial origin as well as the use of illegal or unregulated fishing gears
- **9. Make a responsible use of radio and navigation instruments**, not risking people and vessels safety, warning in this case, the presence of floating objects or other dangers and always putting into practice the **obligation of providing assistance at sea**
