## INTRODUCTION

The Abanca 52 Super Series Baiona Sailing Week is organised by the Super Series Eventos Desportivos LDA in collaboration with the Monte Real Club de Yates de Baiona (MRCYB) and the TP52 class, collectively the Organizing Authority (OA). The Event Sailing Instructions (ESI) give the 'local' instructions not mentioned in the 2022 NoR/SI and in case of clashes overrules the 2022 NoR/SI.

### 1) SCHEDULE OF RACES, INSPECTIONS, CEREMONIES AND BRIEFINGS

26 May, Thursday:	12.30 First warning signal WL Races
27 May, Friday:	12.30 First warning signal WL Races
28 May, Saturday:	12.30 First warning signal WL Races <b>17.00</b> Earliest option Prize Giving (NoR/SI 15.7: no warning signal will be made after 15:30h except because of a general recall)

Maximum number of races: 10

The location for the skipper's meeting: MRCYB clubhouse, to be specified for exact location.

### 2) COURSE AREA

Races will be sailed in the waters of Baiona. Most likely in the blue area indicated below.



### 3) HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

Boats shall not be hauled out after 19<sup>th</sup> May 2022 /18.00h except with and according to the terms of prior written authorisation of the race committee.

### 4) (FORBIDDEN) PASSAGES

The passage between *Isla Estela de Tierra* and *Monteferro* can be used to shorten the route to and from the race course area, but the advice is to only attempt this in smooth sea conditions. The organization will indicate the sea state daily but the choice is with the skipper.

### 5) MARKS

Smartmarks (<https://mysmartmark.com>) will be used from Baiona. All Smartmarks will be of the cone type and colours will be as indicated in the 2022 NoR/SI Appendix 1, **except that mark W will be a YELLOW mark.**

Please note: Course 3 (Pennant 3) will not be used in Baiona.

### 8) CREW WEIGHT + INDIVIDUAL CREW PHOTO

On 22 May, Sunday, from 16.30 sailing crew will be checked for the event crew weight.

Straight after being weighed please proceed with the **full crew, including shore crew**, to the event photo location (to be communicated on the ONB) where each crew member shall be photographed, wearing team shirt and trousers, against the 52 Super Series backdrop by the event photographer. These photos will be used to update the 52 Super Series website for this year's teams.

As taking the photos will take somewhat longer than taking the weights, please do not wander too far off from the photo location and/or communicate with the photographer or his assistant when to return to the location. Please realize this photo will be on display for at least one year on the website. Only reasonable requests for having another try and replacing the first photo will be rewarded. This to the judgement of the OA. Look smart!!

If no option to do both on 22 May, Sunday, crew weight and photo can also be done at 09.00, 23 May, Monday. Please arrange with the measurer and the event photographer.
